Each skater should bring the following items to camp daily...

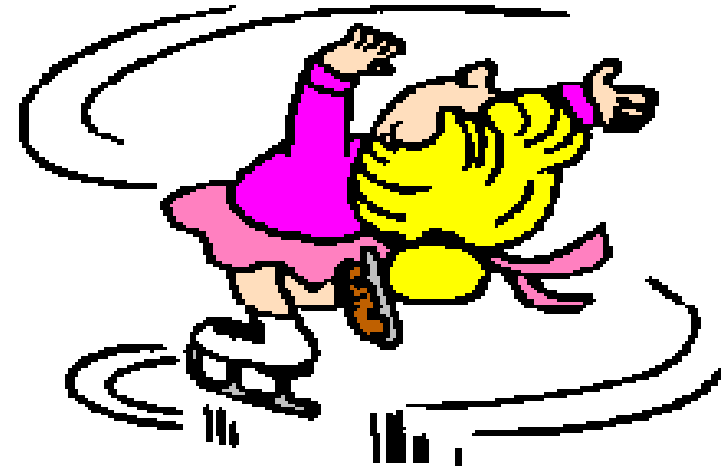
- Sneakers (required for off-ice class)
